Clothing & Accessories

- Bedding (sheets, blankets, comforters, pillows)
- Women's clothing (dresses, blouses, skirts, etc.)
- Baby or kids' clothing
- Towels, washcloths, or any bathroom linens
- Items with stains, rips, or excessive wear
- Heavily worn or stained men's clothing (dress shirts, ties, socks, shoes)
- Outdated formal wear (old-fashioned suits, tuxedos)
- Branded promotional T-shirts (corporate logos, team-building events)
- Worn-out hats, caps, or single gloves, socks, and shoes
- Used belts with cracked leather or damaged buckles
- Old or worn ties and pocket squares

Household, Furniture, & Large Items

- Any type of furniture (couches, chairs, tables, beds)
- Large or heavy appliances
- Broken or damaged household furniture
- Kitchenware (pots, pans, utensils, dishes, glassware)
- Small kitchen appliances (toasters, coffee makers, blenders)
- General household decor (vases, lamps, wall art)
- Broken or incomplete furniture (missing hardware or mismatched pieces)

Kids & Baby Items

- Toys, games, or puzzles designed for children
- Baby gear (strollers, cribs, car seats)
- Children's books, DVDs, or educational materials

Tools, Automotive, & Workshop Items

- Non-functioning or rusted tools (hammers, screwdrivers, power drills, saws)

- Cracked, chipped, or non-functional items
- Craft supplies (yarn, knitting needles, scrapbooking materials)
- Holiday decorations focused on children or families (e.g., Easter baskets, kid-themed Christmas ornaments)
- Overly personalized items (custom-made or man-themed furniture)
